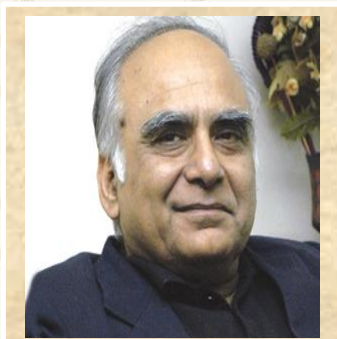

Prof. NK Ganguly obtained MBBS from University of Calcutta, MD (Microbiology) from Post-graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh and D.Sc (hc) from the University of Calcutta. Dr Ganguly was the Acting Director of PGIMER, Chandigarh; Director of National Institute of Biologicals, Noida. He was the President of National Academy of Medical Sciences, New Delhi; Asian Society of Diarrhoeal Diseases and Nutrition (2000-03); International Society of Health Research (Indian Chapter); President JIPMER Pondicherry, President Indian National Science Congress. Academy of Cardiovascular Sciences (Indian Chapter); Chairman of Lancefield International Society on Streptococci and Streptococcal Diseases and Honorary Visiting Professor of number of universities and institutes. He was the Director General, ICMR, New Delhi (1998-2007) and Advisor to Union Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India.

Research Achievements

Prof. Ganguly's major research areas have been tropical diseases, cardiovascular diseases and diarrhoeal diseases. His area of specialization is infection and has wide ranging interests in this area from immunology to biotechnology and public health. He has published over seven hundred papers and guided hundred and thirty Ph.D theses as guide/co-guide.

Awards and Honours

Prof. Ganguly has been awarded Padma Bhushan (2008) by the Government of India. He has won more than hundred awards. Notable among them are INSA's Shambu Nath De Memorial Lecture Award, and Dr Yellapragada Subba Rao Memorial Lecture Award; Ranbaxy Research Award; Om Prakash Bhasin Award; FICCI Award; Goyal Prize; Norman Alpert Award; Annual Award of International Spirit of Life Foundation, USA; Excellence in Science and Technology Award of the Indian Science Congress Association; SS Bhatnagar Medal; Medal of Merit of International Academy of Cardiovascular Sciences, Canada; ICMR Awards; and Professor Niranjana S Dhalla Award of the Indian Pharmacology Society. He is a Fellow of Imperial College Faculty of Medicine, London and Royal College of Pathologists, London. He is also a Fellow of National Academy of Medical Sciences, New Delhi; National Academy of Sciences, Allahabad and Indian Academy of Sciences, Bangalore. He is a fellow of Third World Academy.
